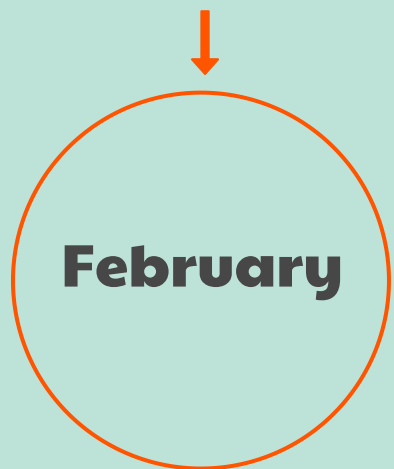

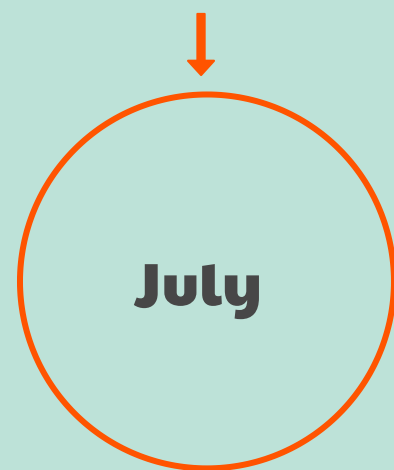

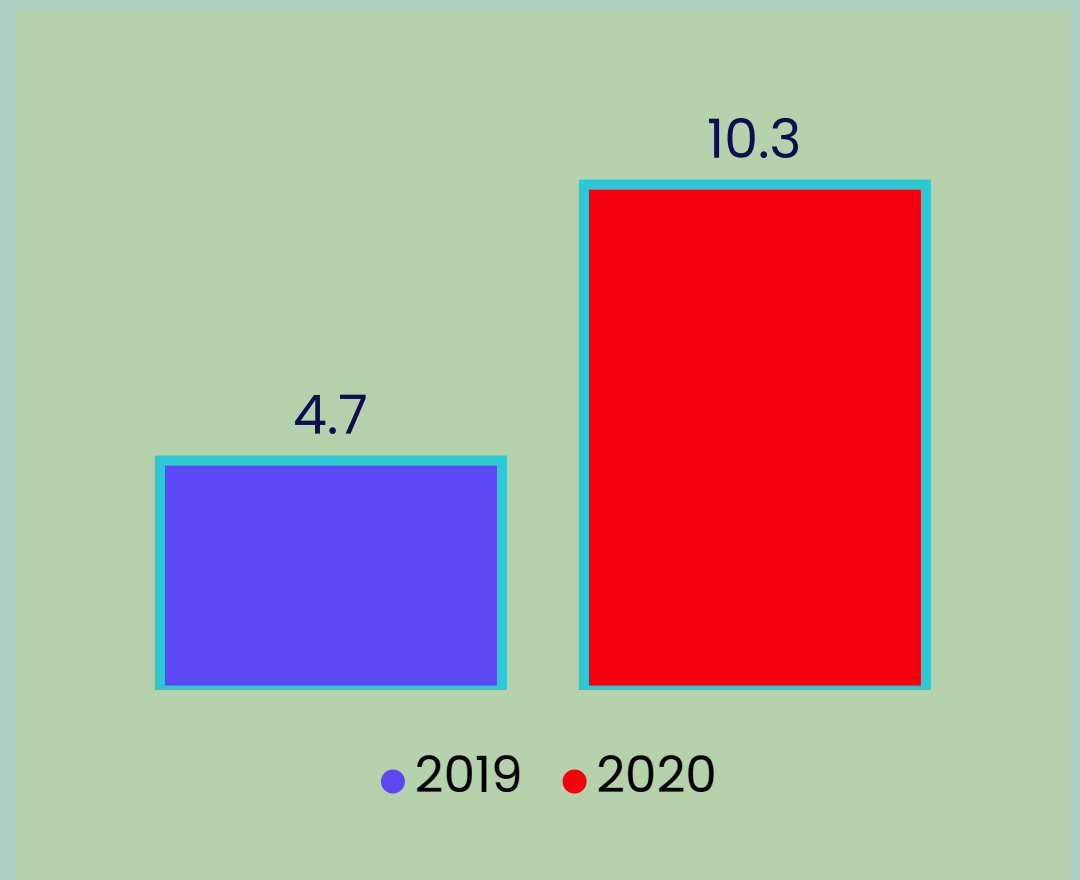


Increased wildfires in the world, mainly in Brazil, United States and Australia;

Increase of Million Acres Burned from 2019 to 2020 in United States



Despite the amount of forest fires 13% higher than the previous year (2019 with 50477 and 2020 with 57000), there was an increase of 120% of millions of acres (more than 10.3 million acres were burned during this year).
